1. To: ALL MATH students admitted *in 2022-23 or before*.

Subject: Capstone courses (MATH4400, MATH4900).

If you wish to graduate *by summer 2026*, you have to take a capstone course to fulfill graduation requirement. For details, refer to the homepage

There is a one-off waiving of the portion of pre-requisite “MATH2221” in the academic year 2025-26. So even if you have not passed MATH2221 as of July 2025, you are still eligible for taking MATH4400 or MATH4900 as long as you have fulfilled the rest of the pre-requisite for the respective course as stated in CUSIS.

2. To: ALL BMED students admitted *in 2023-24*.

Subject: MATH2050, MATH2070, MATH2230.

- (a) If you intend to take MATH2050 in 2025-26, you are advised to do so in the first semester. It is unlikely that you will find any place in the second semester section of MATH2050.
- (b) According to the BMED study scheme, you are supposed to complete MATH2070, MATH2230 in 2025-26. If you postpone these courses beyond 2025-26, you may be prevented from taking these courses due to time clash issues with your other required courses, and may be faced with an increased risk of deferring your graduation.

3. To: ALL MIEG students admitted *in 2023-24*.

Subject: MATH2050, MATH2060, MATH2070, MATH2230.

You will be pre-assigned to some specific first semester sections of MATH2050, MATH2230, and to some specific second semester sections of MATH2060, MATH2070.

Please be reminded that it is unlikely that you will find any place in the second semester sections of MATH2050, MATH2230, and in the 2026-27 first semester sections of MATH2060, MATH2070.

4. To: ALL BMED students admitted *in 2024-25*.

Subject: MATH2020, MATH2040.

You will be pre-assigned to some specific second semester sections of MATH2020, MATH2040.

Please be reminded that it is unlikely that you will find any place in the 2026-27 first semester sections of MATH2020, MATH2040.

5. To: ALL MIEG students admitted *in 2024-25*.

Subject: MATH2010, MATH2020, MATH2040.

You will be pre-assigned to some specific first semester sections of MATH2010, MATH2040, and to the second semester section of MATH2020.

Please be reminded that it is unlikely that you will find any place in the second semester sections of MATH2010, MATH2040, and in the 2026-27 first semester section of MATH2020.

6. To: ALL MATH/BMED students admitted *in 2023-24 or 2024-25*.

Subject: MATH2221.

- (a) According to the study scheme applicable to you, you are expected to take MATH2221 in the second semester of your second year of study.
- (b) For MATH students *specifically*: From 2025-26 onwards, MATH2221 will be part of the pre-requisite for the capstone courses MATH4400, MATH4900. From 2026-27 onwards, NO student will be allowed to register for the Capstone course without first passing MATH2221.
- (c) Due to physical constraints of equipment, you must plan your study under the assumption that the class quota for the various sections of MATH2221 is strict. NO student in the waiting list of any section of MATH2221 should take for granted that add-in beyond the CUSIS class quota is possible.

7. To: ALL students admitted *in 2025-26* who intend to graduate in the MATH/BMED/MIEG programmes.

Subject: Year 1 study pattern of MATH courses in MATH/BMED/MIEG programmes.

The MATH/BMED/MIEG study scheme that applies to you differs greatly from that which applies to students admitted in previous years.

Students who intend to graduate in the MATH/BMED programmes are expected to take MATH1010/1018 and MATH1025/1028 in the first semester 2025-26, and to take MATH1030/1038 and MATH1090/1098 in the second semester 2025-26.

Students who intend to graduate in the MIEG programme are expected to take MATH1010/1018 in the first semester 2025-26, and to take MATH1025/1028 and MATH1030/1038 in the second semester 2025-26.

8. To: ALL students.

Subject: MATH3270.

Two sections of MATH3270 will be offered in 2025-26, one in the first semester, and the other in the second semester. The course will NOT be offered in the summer semester.
